Task

While working at Vault Furniture I was contracted to make a custom end table utilizing materials used in various company pieces seen by the customers at a local art show. Constrained by precise dimensions and desired materials, I worked to build a realistic 3D model to present to the customer for review.



Realistic Rendering

In order to create the most accurate rendering possible for the customer I was able to create texture files from photographs of the actual materials to be used in construction.



Finishes

Given my enthusiasm for functionalism I aimed to use finishes that were as minimalist as possible allowing for the materials to speak for themselves. As such I used a wax wiping coat on all steel parts after welding and drilling was finished which allows the steel to still appear rusted without any concern for rust wiping off when handling or brushing against. For the wood I used Vault Furniture's standard indoor wood finish a water based clear coat that helps accentuate the contrast in the wood.
